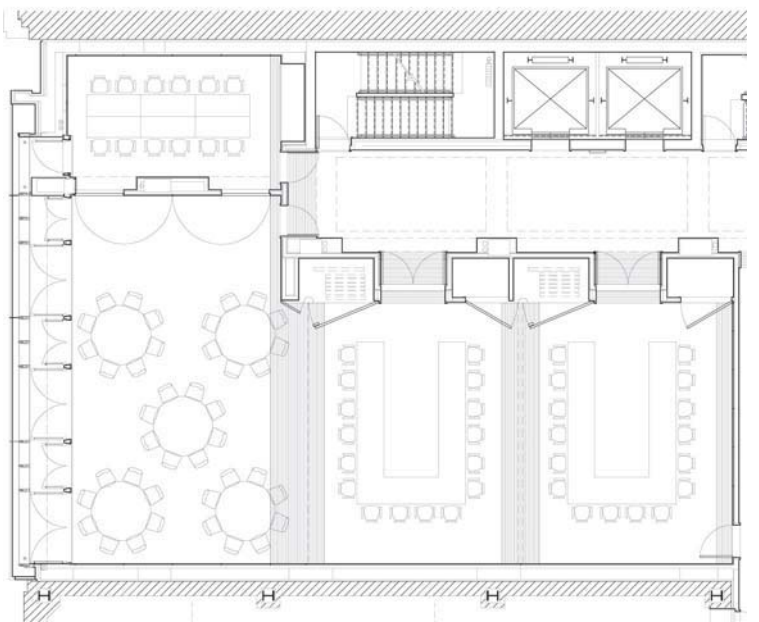
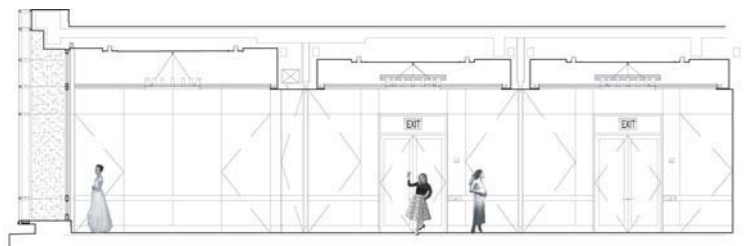


# Harvard Club of New York

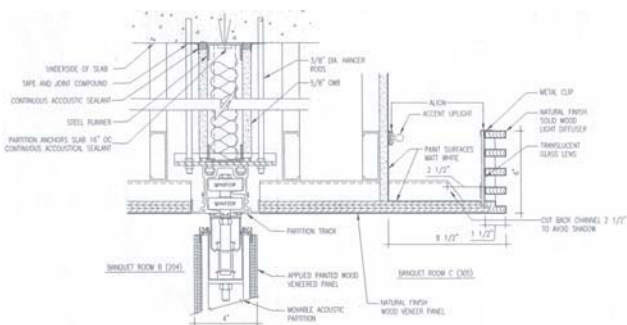


The Harvard Club of New York expansion ties into the historic club building with an extension of each of the floors' functions. New floors align with and connect to existing floor levels. The ground floor extends the lobby functions into the new building. Media, meeting and event spaces occupy the 2nd and third floors and address the street with a double layer facade with privacy shutters at the interior. Additional hotel rooms are provided on the 4th and 5th floors, staff offices occupy the 6th floor, and an expanded fitness center on the 7th and 8th floors contains a gym and international squash courts.

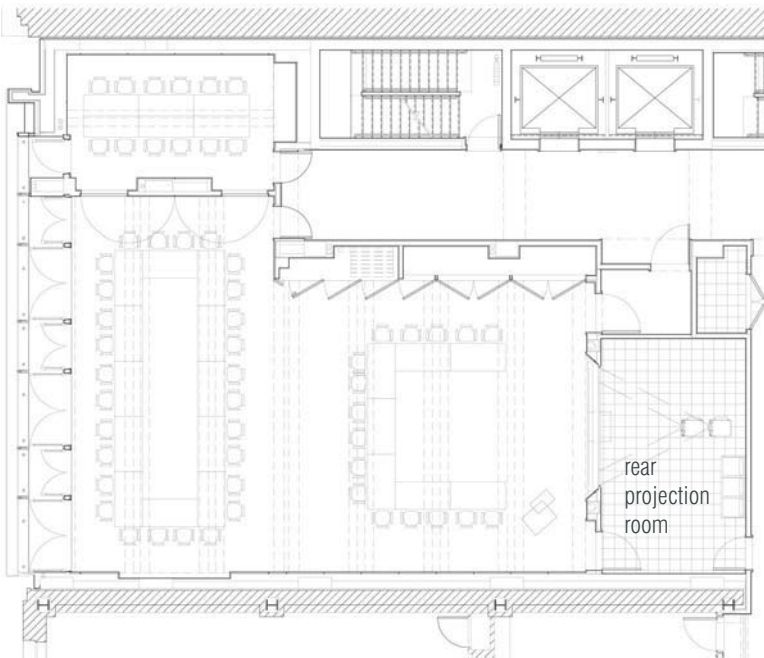
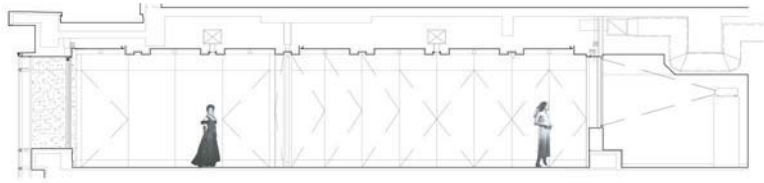




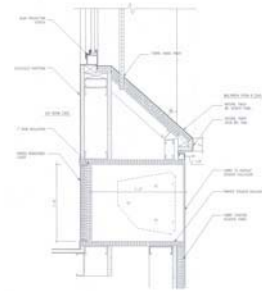
Banquet Room Plan and Section



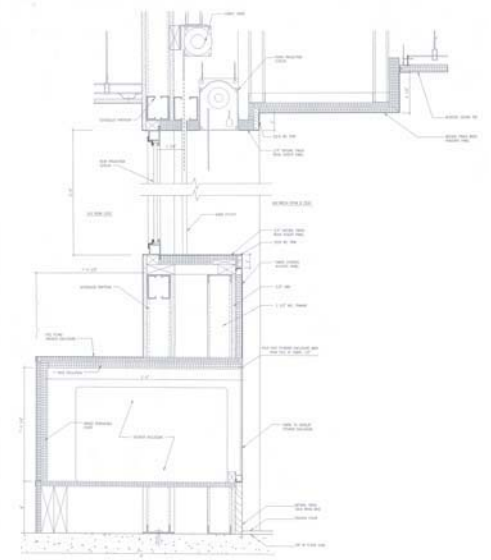
The 2nd floor banquet room can be subdivided into three separate event spaces via a moveable acoustic separation panel.
